In this week-long summer clay camp, students will learn to sculpt expressive human busts using the slab construction method, guided by artis Stephanie Oplinger. Students will explore facial expression and anatomy while building their own unique clay bust. Through hands-on demos, creative exercises, and guided critique, participants will gain confidence in clay handbuilding techniques and learn how sculpture can tell powerful stories and expressions.

How can you add strong visual interest to a drawing/design? This class starts with an intro/review of basic drawing approaches and assigned practice work applied to improving your observational eye. Working with various marking techniques that imply pattern/texture and value contrasts that suggest form/space, students explore options for presenting their subject imagery in a visually dynamic manner. Linear perspective methods are also presented for consideration.

Bring a pencil and sketchpad to first class. Other material options will then be discussed

This class will introduce you to the fundamentals of designing in linear perspective. After the principles of 1 pt -2 pt and 3 pt perspective have been presented, it's creative application in various subject matter will be explored. How does linear perspective affect the design of still life, figure, landscape, architectural, mechanical, and free-form design? This class will present those topics through a series of drawing experiences. Bring a straight edge and triangle to the first class and then other materials will be discussed.

Independent Study in Clay and Open Studio with Johanna Sheppard

Raku Workshop

Raku is a traditional low fire process that results in unpredictable yet brilliant colors and effects. The Raku workshop is a one-day Raku firing of already bisque fired raku clay pieces. All those signed up will actively participate in the outdoor firing process so prepare for a long day! All participants will receive 12 ½ lbs of clay prior to the workshop date. The pottery studio will be available for workshop participants (3 sessions).- Work independently. Other times may be available. Greenware pieces must be dried out and at the Art Center by Sept for bisque firing. Optional glazing session Sept 5 Age 18 or older
